



Policy for Alcohol and/or Drug Use Amnesty

The health and safety of every student at Erie Community College is of utmost importance. Erie Community College recognizes that students who have been drinking and/or using drugs (whether such use is voluntary or involuntary) at the time that violence, including but not limited to domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, or sexual assault occurs and may be hesitant to report such incidents due to fear of potential consequences for their own conduct.

Erie Community College strongly encourages students to report domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, or sexual assault to institution officials. A bystander acting in good faith or a reporting individual acting in good faith that discloses any incident of domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, or sexual assault to Erie Community College officials or law enforcement will not be subject to Erie Community College's code of conduct action for violations of alcohol and/or drug use policies occurring at or near the time of commission of the domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, or sexual assault.
